# **Capacity Planning**



Planning for an unknown volume, at an unknown time, with unknown rules and regulations....

- How to calculate capacity in a post moratorium world
  - O With improved efficiencies, are old models still relevant?
  - o How will delays effect throughput?
  - o Forbearance extensions?
- Returning/repurposing staff
  - When to ramp up
  - Training programs
  - Modification of workflows
  - New process planning



# **Delays – Planned (and ....Surprises)**



- Clerks/recorders
  - Remember the past!
- o Courts
  - Filing delays (HUD 1<sup>st</sup> legal)
  - o SOL concerns
  - Overwhelmed dockets/Order entry and judgment delays
  - Bankruptcy surge
- New rules/regulations
  - Additional affidavits, etc.
- Overwhelmed vendors
  - o Title
- o Sheriff refusals
- Litigation
  - Surge in COVID defenses
- Social unrest/Protests
- Tracking COVID delays for claim purposes

Partnership and communication is more critical now than ever...

- Proceed wherever possible to lessen backlogs
  - Pre-order title
- Document execution
  - With remote staff, design procedures
- Transparency
  - Volume projections are <u>critical!</u>
    - o Immediate
    - o 90 & 120 day projections



## **Financial Considerations**



## Ongoing viability – The \$1M (or lack of) question

- Operations
  - Financial Statements A false flag?
  - O Does the "flat fee" model still work as moratoriums become more common?
  - o Maintenance/Hold fees?
  - Transfer fees
  - Restart fees
- Capital Requirements
  - Cost advancement When volume returns, current model of firms providing up front costs and waiting for reimbursement should be examined.
- Ethical Considerations
  - Can firms be expected to bear the burden of unknown costs for an unknown period of time?
